## CITY OF JAMAICA BEACH ORDINANCE 2024-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS, REPEALING ALL PREVIOUS MINOR CURFEW ORDINANCES THAT ARE IN CONFLICT WITH THE STATE OF TEXAS HOUSE BILL 1819 THAT BANS LOCAL GOVERNMENTS FROM ENFORCING CURFEWS FOR MINORS.

Whereas the State of Texas House Bill 1819 that went into effect September 1, 2023, bans local governments from enforcing curfews for minors.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Jamaica Beach, Texas:
