# CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

MAY 18, 2020 6:00 P.M.

#### **CALL TO ORDER**

1. CITY OF JAMAICA BEACH FINANCIAL AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2019. Alpha Jallow with Katherine Overbeck-Maxwell Accounting Firm attended the meeting to present the Financial Audit for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2019.

CONSIDER FOR ACTION APPROVING AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING USAGE AND PARKING REGULATIONS FOR THE CITY OWNED JAMAICA BEACH REGATTA BASIN FACILITY (ALSO KNOWN AS THE "MARINA"), LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF BASIN DRIVE AND ALL OF BASIN DRIVE; TO PROVIDE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS; TO PROVIDE VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Alderman Rupertus motioned to approve the above stated Ordinance. Second by Alderman Kurtz-Hoffman. Motion unanimously approved by those present. Creating Ordinance 2020-3.

#### CITY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

City Administrator Hutchison reported on the following: UTMB will be conducting free COVID-19 testing for Galveston County residents, please visit the city's website for more information; warning that water may be interrupted for a short period while the water meters are connected; Annual Spring Cleanup scheduled to be conducted on Saturday, June 13th, contact City Hall to get on the heavy trash list; Annual Hurricane Preparedness Meeting cancelled; City Council will be holding a Public Hearing on June 1st on the City of Jamaica Beach Vehicular Beach Access Plan; reminder that JBPD will be enforcing the Leave No Trace Ordinance barring people from leaving personal property on the public beach between the hours of sunset to sunrise; seeking volunteers to help pick-up trash on the beach.

Alderman Morris spoke in favor of opening the city's swimming pool; spoke in favor of conducting the Annual Citywide Garage Sale; looking forward to the Public Hearing on June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Alderman Rupertus noted Memorial weekend was coming up; be prepared for the crowds, be safe and have a wonderful Memorial weekend.

Alderman Kurtz-Hoffman reported she is looking forward to the pool opening up and the Public Hearing on June 1st; she encouraged citizens to submit their comments to the city and not on social media sites that are not affiliated with the city, because those comments/posts do not get translated to the city.

Alderman Rizzo suggests the Annual Citywide Garage Sale be conducted on July 4th.

#### POLICE REPORT

Police Chief Heiman reported the JBPD will be extra staffed and prepared for the Memorial weekend; he noted the only time the city has the authority to temporarily shut down beach access to vehicles is when it's overly crowded that adding another vehicle would become a safety hazard.
