CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL BUDGET WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES

JULY 13, 2015 5:30 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Spicer called the meeting to order.

PLEDGES OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE U.S. AND TEXAS FLAGS

Alderman Sherwood Green led the Pledges of Allegiance to the U.S. and Texas Flags.

ITEMS OF BUSINESS:

1. DISCUSS FY 2014/2015 BUDGETS.

Mayor Spicer, Council and staff discussed current budget line items according to June's Financial Reports. Council discussed Budget line item transfers do to unforeseen overages.

2. DISCUSS FY 2015/2016 PROPOSED BUDGETS.

Council and staff discussed the following proposed budget items: City Administrator Brick said he would like Council to consider the following annual requested items: employee salary increases; 10% employee retirement contribution; and employee incentive check in December. He would also like Council to consider budgeting \$20,000 for shade at the

swimming pool. Police Chief Chapa asked Council to consider increasing the dispatch budget to \$8,000; he noted JBPD's dispatch is currently being provided by Galveston County Sheriff's Department for free, but he plans to switch to the City of Galveston for a fee of \$500 per month or \$6,000 annually; he noted there will be no additional fees to switch dispatch services. City

Secretary Rushing noted the current \$2,000 dispatch expense is for the wireless service in their patrol vehicles. Chief Chapa is requesting an additional \$10,000 for a new patrol vehicle. Mayor Spicer noted \$40,000 will be encumbered from the current FY if it's not used. Chief Chapa requests to hire a PT Secretary for the Police Department. Mayor Spicer comments he did not think a Secretary was necessary for the Police Department. Mayor Spicer said he would like to conduct another Budget Meeting on July 20th after the Regular Called Meeting.
