DECEMBER 5, 2011 6:00 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER

MPT Eddie Burke called the meeting to order.

PLEDGES OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE U.S. AND TEXAS FLAG

ITEMS OF BUSINESS:

1. DISCUSS APPROVING CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JAMAICA BEACH AND LEAP ENGINEERING FOR EROSION RESPONSE PLAN.

City Administrator Brick mentioned the contract was approved by Council on July 18th with the General Land Office, but since LEAP is doing the work and we would be paying them, Council will need to consider approving a contract with LEAP.

2. DISCUSS BANK DEPOSITORY BIDS.

City Administrator Brick said the City received two bids: one from Moody National Bank and the second from Texas First Bank; he said a letter was received from HomeTown Bank declining to bid. City Administrator Brick presented Council a copy of the bids for their review.

Ginger Jones, 16612 Curlew, inquired if the interest rate changed or if it was the same between the years. Mat McConnell, 4306 Karankawa, commented on the interest rates rather they would go down again or not.

3. DISCUSS EMPLOYEE INCENTIVE CHECKS.

City Administrator Brick said the employee incentive check is an annual incentive distributed in December to full-time employees, part-time Police Officer's receive \$300.

4. DISCUSS THE PURCHASE OF "IT EQUIPEMENT" FOR PD OFFICES, FUNDING REIMBURSED BY THE OSSI GRANT.

Chief McLane explained the purchase of 4 new desktop computers and 1 new server for the Police Department; he said the purchase would be reimbursed by the OSSI grant.
