# CITY COUNCIL CALLED MEETING MINUTES

APRIL 21, 2014 6:00 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Steve Spicer called the meeting to order.

#### **ITEMS OF BUSINESS:**

1. DISCUSS AND CONSIDER FOR ACTION AUTHORIZING THE FUNDING OF THE MEMORIAL DAY DANCE WITH MONIES TO COME FROM THE PARK BOARD FUND, AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000.

Alderman Morse motion to authorize the funding of the Memorial Day Dance. Second by MPT Burke. Unanimously approved by those present.

2. CONSIDER FOR ACTION ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE FOR AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE TO USE. Item tabled. 3. CONSIDER FOR ACTION RE-AWARDING OF CONTRACT FOR LIFTSTATIONS & WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS WITH JOHN MERCER.

Alderman Montgomery motioned to re-award the contract for the liftstations & wastewater treatment plant improvements. Second by MPT Burke. Alderman Montgomery amended his motion to award the contract to McDonald Electric for \$330,470. Second by MPT Burke. Unanimously approved by those present.

- 4. CONSIDER FOR ACTION VARIANCE REQUEST FOR BOAT DOCK AT 4223 JOLLY ROGER. Alderman Montgomery motioned to approve the variance request for the boat dock at 4223 Jolly Roger. Second by Alderman Morse. Unanimously approved by those present.
- 5. CONSIDER FOR ACTION APPROVING A RESOLUTION TO PROCLAIM APRIL 2014 AS FAIR HOUSING MONTH.

Alderman Morse motioned to approve a Resolution to proclaim April 2014 as Fair Housing month. Second by Alderman Montgomery. Unanimously approved by those present.

6. CONSIDER FOR ACTION PROPOSAL TO RAKE AND CLEAN BEACH FROM BEACHSIDE ENVIRONMENTAL.

MPT Burke motioned to approve the proposal from Beachside Environmental to rake and clean the beach. Second by Alderman Morse. Unanimously approved by those present.

- 7. CONSIDER FOR ACTION PURCHASE OF A GOLFCART FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT. Alderman Morse motioned to approve the purchase of a golfcart for the Police Department. Second by MPT Burke. Alderman Morse amended her motion to include for the purchase not to exceed \$8,000. Second by MPT Burke. Unanimously approved by those present.
- 8. CONSIDER FOR ACTION APPOINTMENT OF PARK BOARD MEMBERS. Alderman Morse motioned to appoint Taz Jones to the Park Board. Second by Alderman Montgomery. Unanimously approved by those present.

### CITY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

City Administrator Brick announced beach clean-up, Spring heavy trash pick-up and the city-wide garage sale is all this weekend; reminded Council we will only conduct one Council meeting on May 19<sup>th</sup>; around 500 automatic water meters have been installed; and the street work improvements are almost complete. **MAYOR'S REPORT**
