- 1. CONSIDER FOR ACTION APPROVING THE MINUTES OF THE FOLLOWING MEETING:

3. CONSIDER FOR ACTION AWARDING A BID FOR THE WATER LINE EXTENSION FOR 2 ADDITIONAL FIRE HYDRANTS.

Alderman Rupertus motioned to award the bid to Mercer Construction; he noted in his motion the water line extension is for 3 fire hydrants not 2. Second by Alderman Hudson. Motion unanimously approved.

 CONSIDER FOR ACTION ADOPTING A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE GALVESTON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT NOMINATIONS TO THE GALVESTON COUNTY UNITED BOARD OF HEALTH.

Alderman Green motioned to adopt a Resolution endorsing the Galveston County Commissioners' Court nominations to the Galveston County United Board of Health. Second by MPT Montgomery. Motion unanimously approved by those present.

5. CONSIDER FOR ACTION APPROVING THE ANNUAL INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AND COBRA CONTINUATION OF COVERAGE ADMINISTRATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN TML MULTISTATE INTERGOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEE BENEFITS POOL AND THE CITY OF JAMAICA BEACH.

Alderman Rupertus motioned to approve the Annual Interlocal Agreement and Cobra Continuation of Coverage Administrative Agreement between TML-IEBP and the City of Jamaica Beach. Second by Alderman Hudson. Motion unanimously approved.
