CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES

JUNE 3, 2013 6:00 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Steve Spicer called the meeting to order.

PLEDGES OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE U.S. AND TEXAS FLAGS

ITEMS OF BUSINESS:

1. DISCUSS APPOINTMENT OF MAYOR PRO-TEM.

Mayor Spicer said Eddie Burke is the current MPT.

Alderman Montgomery said he thinks MPT Burke is doing a good job.

Mayor Spicer asked if any other Councilmember was interested or would like to be considered as Mayor Pro-Tem. No other recommendations from Council. No further discussion.

2. DISCUSS DIRECTING CITY STAFF TO ADVERTISE THE POLICE CHIEF POSITION.

Mayor Spicer recommended city staff to post the Police Chief position. No further discussion.

 DISCUSS AMENDING ORDINANCE 2009-4 ADOPTING GOLF CART AND OTHER SLOW MOVING VEHICLE REGULATIONS AND CITY REQUIREMENTS.

Alderman Denby said she requested the item be placed on the agenda for discussion; she is noticing a lot more golf carts around the city and suggests amending the ordinance by requiring an annual registration fee as a way to make sure golf carts are insured and in compliance with the ordinance plus it would be additional revenue for the city.

MPT Burke said he doesn't see golf carts as an issue; he said he doesn't like to see under age kids driving them.

Alderman South said the amendment in 2009 was to no longer require license plates on golf carts; he said the current

Alderman Montgomery asked the JBPD if they were having any issues or problems with golf carts.

Acting Chief Sedgwick and Cpl. Todaro both replied they have not had many issues with golf carts.

Mayor Spicer was against the annual registration fee; he thought of it as an extra tax to the citizens and was not in favor of extra taxes.
