## CITY OF JAMAICA BEACH ORDINANCE NO. 2023-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS REPEALING ORDINANCE 2001-3 IN IT'S ENTIRETY; REALIGNMENT OF COUNCIL POSITIONS BY ALLOWING FOR THE MAYOR'S TERM TO BE FOR ONE YEAR IN THE MAY 4, 2002, ELECTION; FINDING COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Repeal: Ordinance 2001-3, adopted by the City of Jamaica Beach City Council on July 16, 2001, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be and become effective from and after its adoption.
