Infrastructure

- Ignored for too long
- Half of waste water treatment plant is inoperable
- Sewer lines need evaluation and cleaning
- Manholes leak
- Water meters at end of their life
- Significant water ingress during rain and high tide

Status

- Completed 2 more sections of Water line replacement
- Upgraded 2 lift stations
- Bid and completing upgrades to remaining lift stations
- Small section of sewer lines scoped and cleaned
- Inoperable side of treatment plant is cleaned and isolated from other side
- Priority focus on finalizing overall infrastructure plan



- Technology
 - Ignored for too long
- Status
 - Moving all applications to web based cloud access
 - Removes server and the need for server maintenance
 - Allows remote work during need to evacuate
 - Eliminates unsupported software applications
 - Most software moving to cloud platform
 - Water Billing
 - Cloud Permit (Short Term Rental payments and registration, Building permits, Code Enforcement, Marina Permits)
 - Police Camera systems
 - Court software
 - Accounting software
 - Pursuing Starlink for backup and mobile internet access



Maintenance

- Status
 - Elevator being updated
 - New roof at City Hall
 - Deck refurbishment at pool
 - Filters at pool
 - Pumps at pool
 - Pavilion doors painted
 - Fans at pavilion (Proposal to install heaters in the fall)



- Communications/Technology
 - Progress but room for improvement
- Status
 - Website updated
 - Old website archived
 - Online sign up for heavy trash pickup
 - Online reservation system for beach Mobi Chair
 - All Ordinances now available
 - Cloud permit will allow website access to online Building permits, Marina permits, Short Term Rental registrations and Hotel/motel tax payments
 - Blackboard utilized for time critical communications
 - City Facebook page
 - New phone system allows remote connection

- Optimizing location for beach dumpsters
- Preliminary discussions with GLO regarding Beach User Fee options
