



WHEREAS, by virtue of the powers vested in the Village of Jamaica Beach, Texas, by Article 961, V.A.T.C.S., the Village officers have the authority to adopt Title 28, Chapters 1 through 10, V.A.T.C.S.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS,

Section 1: That Title 28, Chapters 1 through 10, V.A.T.C.S., its provisions and articles, are hereby adopted in full.

Section 2: That the Village of Jamaica Beach, Texas, shall henceforth be governed and regulated by the general laws of the State of Texas as provided by Title 28, Chapters 1 through 10, V.A.T.C.S.


Section 3: That, inasmuch as the Village of Jamaica Beach, Texas, is not divided into wards, henceforth, the Village Council shall be composed of a mayor and five aldermen, elected at large for a term of two years, and by such other officers and/or agents as the Village Council may, from time to time, direct, which additional officers and/or agents shall either be appointed and/or elected as provided by ordinance.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall be, and become, effective from and after its adoption and publication, as required by law.
