

ORDINANCE NO. 79-5

An Ordinance Prohibiting the Discharge of firearms and air-guns within the Corporate Limits of the Village of Jamacia Beach and Establishing a Penalty for the Violation thereof.


Be It Ordained By the Village Council of the Village of Jamacia Beach, Texas:

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge or cause to be discharged any gun, pistol, shotgun, rifle, or other firearm, or airgun, beebie gun, pellet gun, or any toy gun projecting lead or any missile; provided that this section shall not be construed to prohibit any officer of the law from discharging a firearm in the performance of his duty; nor to any citizen from discharging a firearm when lawfully defending person or property.

Any person convicted under any of the provisions of this section shall be fined in any sum not exceeding two hundred dollars (\$200.00)
