

ORDINANCE 99-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VILLAGE OF JAMAICA BEACH, TEXAS ESTABLISHING A VIOLATION FOR INTRUDING ON PREMISES AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$500.00.

WHEREAS, it shall be unlawful for a person to enter or remain upon the premises of another without the effective consent of the owner or occupier of the premises.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Jamaica Beach, Texas, finds it in the best interest of law enforcement and the citizens of the City of Jamaica Beach to establishing Ordinance 99-04 to prohibit unlawful intruding on the premises.

WHEREAS, a violation of this section shall be a Class C misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars. (\$500.00).

This Ordinance shall be and become effective from and after the date of its adoption and publication as required by law.
