The Marina is private facility that is for permitted Jamaica Beach residents and their permitted guest ONLY. Permit applications and proof of residency may be submitted via drop box at Jamaica Beach City Hall, or via email to <u>cityadmin@jamaicabeachtx.gov</u>. Please note that applications may take 1-2 business days to process. Permit fees are subject to change per City Council approval.

Terms of Use:

BEFORE PURCHASING A PERMIT, PLEASE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE TERMS OF USE LISTED BELOW.

- Boat ramp and parking area is for residents only who have secured a proper permit.
- All permit applicants must be verified as a resident prior to the permit being issued. Therefore, you MUST provide your license plate number, as well as proof of residency (DL, Utility Bill, Tax Statement) at the time the application is submitted.
- **Permits are \$15.00** for the first permit issued per residence.
- Additional and Replacement Permits are \$5.00
- Permit fees are non-refundable. Lost/stolen permits will not be reissued; replacement permits may be purchased for \$5.00
- Permit must be visibly displayed placed on the inside of the vehicle's front windshield above the registration emblem.
- NO commercial use. Permits will NOT be issued for commercial use of the boat ramp or parking area.
- Vehicles or trailers are not permitted to park at the Marina for more than (24) consecutive hours.
- Permit does not guarantee a parking space. Parking spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis and are intended for boats that are in use.
- Unattached trailer or recreational vehicle parking not allowed.
- Violations of any of these terms may result in ticketing, towing at the owners expense, and/or revocation of permit per City Ordinance 2021-3.
- Permit holders that allow unauthorized users to access the marina, or that have unlawfully secured a permit for or shared a permit with an unauthorized user are subject to being charged with a misdemeanor offense holding a fine of no less than \$500.
- The City of Jamaica Beach has the right to close the boat ramp and/or parking area for good cause, including but not limited to
 maintenance and repairs or in the event of an emergency.

Hold Harmless/Indemnification Agreement:

I hereby assume the risk associated with the use of the Marina and agree to hold the City of Jamaica Beach, its agents, designees, employees, and elected officials free and harmless at all times from and against all claims, liability, expenses, losses, costs, fines, damages or causes of action of every kind and character, including attorney's fees and costs, whether at trial or appellate levels or otherwise, due to my acts, errors or omissions resulting in bodily injury, including death, or damage to my property or the property of others incident to or in connection with my use of the facility.

By signing, I hereby acknowledge that I have read and agree to abide by the terms, rules, regulations and laws governing the use of the Marina facility. I understand that failure to comply with these rules may result in a fine or civil penalty or the inability to obtain a boat ramp & parking permit.
